

Cookie Notice

1. Introduction

This Cookie Notice explains how Destinus Group B.V. ("Destinus", "we", "us" or "our") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on our website at www.destinus.com (the "Website").

This notice should be read together with our Privacy Notice, which provides further details about how we process personal data.

By managing your cookie preferences through our cookie consent banner, you can control which non-essential cookies are placed on your device.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you visit a website. They allow the website to recognise your device and remember certain information about your visit, such as your preferences or actions.

Similar technologies include pixels (also called web beacons), local storage, and scripts embedded in web pages. This policy covers all such technologies, referred to collectively as "cookies".

Cookies can be "first-party" (set by the website you are visiting) or "third-party" (set by a domain other than the one you are visiting). They can also be "session" cookies (deleted when you close your browser) or "persistent" cookies (remain on your device for a set period or until you delete them).

3. How we use cookies

We use cookies for the following purposes, grouped by category.

3.1 Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the Website to function properly. They enable basic features such as page navigation, security, and access to secure areas. The Website cannot function correctly without them. These cookies do not require your consent under the ePrivacy Directive and Telecommunicatiewet.

3.2 Analytics cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our Website by collecting and reporting information. All data is aggregated and anonymous. These cookies are only placed after you give your consent.

_ga — Google Analytics (GA4) — Distinguishes unique visitors by assigning a randomly generated number — 2 years — First-party

ga[MEASUREMENT_ID] — Google Analytics (GA4) — Maintains session state — 2 years — First-party

We use Google Analytics 4 in analytics-only mode. Advertising features and Google Signals are disabled. IP anonymisation is enabled, meaning your full IP address is not stored by Google.

3.3 Third-party / embedded content cookies

Our Website embeds content from external services. When you consent to this category, these third parties may place their own cookies on your device. We have no control over these cookies; the third party acts as an independent data controller.

YouTube (Google LLC) — Video players — Delivers video content, tracks playback interactions, and may set preferences cookies — YouTube privacy policy

LinkedIn Corporation — Widgets (e.g. follow buttons, company feeds) — Displays LinkedIn content and may collect interaction data — LinkedIn cookie policy

Google LLC — Google Calendar widgets — Displays calendar content and may set functional cookies — Google privacy policy

The specific cookies placed by these services may change over time. Please consult their respective privacy and cookie policies for the most current information.

3.4 Marketing / advertising cookies

We do not currently use marketing or advertising cookies. If this changes in the future, we will update this policy and request your consent before placing any such cookies.

4. Your consent

When you first visit our Website, a cookie consent banner is displayed. Non-essential cookies (analytics and third-party embeds) are not activated until you give your informed consent by clicking "Accept" or by selecting specific categories in the preferences panel.

You are free to accept or reject non-essential cookies. Rejecting them will not affect your ability to browse the Website. The "Accept" and "Reject" options are presented with equal prominence, in accordance with guidance from the Dutch Data Protection Authority and the European Data Protection Board.

Your consent preferences are stored in a cookie on your device so that we can remember your choice on subsequent visits.

5. How to manage or withdraw your consent

You can change or withdraw your cookie consent at any time by using the cookie settings link available in the footer of every page on our Website, or by clicking the cookie icon in the bottom-right corner of the page.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing that took place before you withdrew it.

6. How to control cookies through your browser

In addition to our consent mechanism, most web browsers allow you to manage cookies through their settings. You can typically:

- View the cookies stored on your device.
- Delete individual or all cookies.
- Block first-party and/or third-party cookies.
- Block cookies from specific websites.
- Block all cookies (note: this may impair website functionality).
